School Council Election Day is May 2

Nominations of candidates for election to school councils were accepted in 26 attendance areas across the Yukon from April 11 to April 21, 2016. At the close of nominations at noon on April 21, over 100 candidates had filed nomination papers.

Two school council elections will take place on Monday, May 2, 2016 in the attendance areas of:

- #9 Vanier Catholic Secondary School
- #11 Watson Lake Schools

Voting will take place at these schools between 3 p.m. and 8 p.m. on polling day. Electors who are unable to vote at the polling station may obtain a mail-in ballot by contacting their Returning Officer.

Candidates' information for the two attendance areas where voting is required will be available in the schools, in newspapers and on Elections Yukon's website.

Candidates were elected by acclamation in all other attendance areas, except in Nelna Bessie John (Beaver Creek), where no nomination papers were filed. A list of school council members for all 26 attendance areas will be published after polling day.
